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Here's how Ohtuvayre[®] works



It's delivered directly to your lungs using a nebulizer

- The nebulizer allows you to breathe normally while taking Ohtuvayre
- Taken twice daily, once in the morning and once in the evening



Lung function improved significantly over 3 months*

Ohtuvayre is well tolerated and demonstrated a low rate of side effects

The most common side effects include: back pain, high blood pressure, bladder infection, and diarrhea.

 - This type of pharmacy delivers medicines that aren't available at regular local pharmacies—right to your doorstep.
- 2** You will receive a welcome call from Verona Pathway Plus. They will help identify your insurance coverage and, if needed, **explore financial assistance options.***
- 3** Once approved, your specialty pharmacy will call to **schedule delivery of your Ohtuvayre** and any necessary supplies.

Understanding your costs and coverage*

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Original Medicare

Original Medicare with additional insurance may cover up to 100% of your Ohtuvayre prescription and supplies



80% of the cost of nebulized COPD treatments is covered through Original Medicare after deductible requirements are met



20% is the patient cost, but may be covered by an additional insurance plan (such as Medigap, Medicaid, or employer insurance)

Medicare Advantage



Private insurance companies offer Medicare-approved plans that generally cover 100% of your Ohtuvayre and supplies after meeting your annual out-of-pocket limit

- Costs will vary based upon your annual deductible and out-of-pocket limit.

*The out-of-pocket costs for Ohtuvayre vary dependent on your insurance coverage. Coverage is not guaranteed, so be sure to check with your insurance provider for coverage rules and restrictions.

Commercial



If you are eligible and have commercial insurance, you may pay as little as \$0 per month.[†]

Medicaid



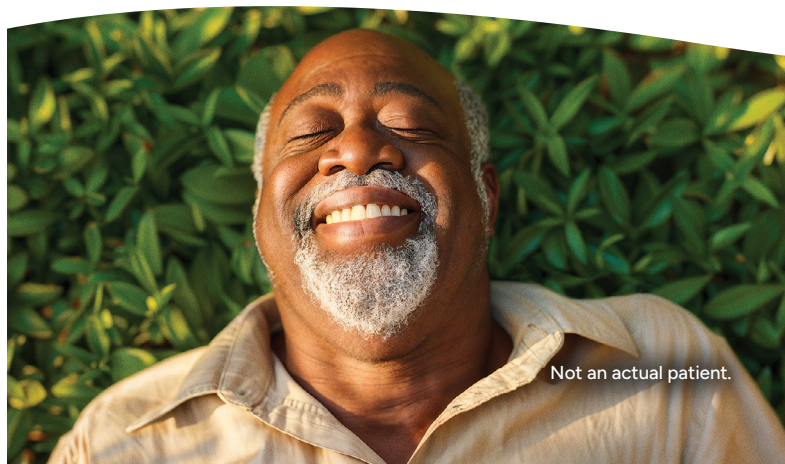
Medicaid patients will generally pay less than \$15 for Ohtuvayre and supplies

Do not use Ohtuvayre to treat sudden breathing problems. Always have a rescue inhaler with you.

Who Should Not use Ohtuvayre?

Do not use Ohtuvayre if you have had an allergic reaction to ensifentrine or any of the ingredients in Ohtuvayre.

What should I tell my healthcare provider before using Ohtuvayre?

Before you use Ohtuvayre, tell your healthcare professional if you have or have had a history of mental health problems including depression and suicidal behavior; have liver problems; are pregnant or plan to become pregnant; are breastfeeding. It is not known if Ohtuvayre may harm your unborn baby. It is not known if the medicine in Ohtuvayre passes into your breast milk and if it can harm your baby.

Tell your healthcare provider about all the medicines you take, including prescription and over-the-counter medicines, vitamins, and herbal supplements.

What are the most common side effects of Ohtuvayre?

The most common side effects of Ohtuvayre include back pain, high blood pressure, bladder infection and diarrhea.
